- Robert Hare (1781-1858): American chemist
- Alfred Russell Wallace (1823-1913): biologist
- Michael Faraday (1791-1867): chemist/physicist
- Sir William Fletcher Barrett (1844-1925): physicist
- Henry Sidgwick (1838-1900): philosopher
- Sir William Crookes (1832-1919): chemist
- J.C.F. Zoellner (1834-1882): astronomer
- Charles Richet\* (1850-1935): physiologist; Nobel prize 1913
- Lord Rayleigh\* [John William Strutt] (1842-1919): physicist, president of the Society for Psychical Research, Nobel prize 1904
- Cesar Lombroso, William James, Thomas Edison, August de Morgan
- Joseph Banks Rhine (1895-1980): botanist; taught psychology at Duke from 1928 to 1950; he directed its parapsychology laboratory from 1940 to 1965.
- John Coover: 1917, he conducted a series of telepathy tests, the first major experimental research on telepathy to be carried out in an American University (Stanford)
- S.G. Soal (1890-1975): mathematics
- Rupert Sheldrake: biology
- Dean Radin, Robert Jahn: engineering
- Charles Honorton, William Braud (psychology), and Adrian Parker: parapsychologists
